TD [Scholarship](#) for Community Leaders  
Closes Nov 13, 2020

- Up to \$70,000 awarded
- Have demonstrated community leadership
- Are in the final year of high school
- Have a minimum overall grade average of 75% in their most recently completed school year

## [Loran Scholarship](#)

School based nomination – 3 per school as well as open application

- Be in your final year of uninterrupted full-time studies in high school
- Present a minimum cumulative average of 85%.
- Hold Canadian citizenship or permanent resident status.
- Be at least 16 years of age by September 1st of the following year.

Schulich Leader [Scholarships](#)  
School based nomination – 1 per school

- High school graduates enrolling in a Science, Technology, Engineering or Math program at one of 20 partner universities across Canada.
- Twenty-five are valued at \$100,000 for engineering scholarships and 25 are valued at \$80,000\* for science and math scholarships.
