Personal Mobile Devices & Social Media in Schools

Personal Mobile Device (PMD)

A personal electronic device that can be used to communicate with or access the internet, such as a cellphone, tablet, laptop, or smartwatch

K-Grade 9		
Grades 10-12	 (But may access for specific educational purposes with approval)	




Storage

PMDs must be stored in a locker (where available) or in another location indicated by the School Personal Mobile Device/Social Media Plan



Medical & Educational Needs

Students may access a PMD for a diagnosed health or medical reason (with a physician's confirmation) and for individualized educational support (as approved by school administration)



Social Media

All schools will have restricted access to social media platforms on school networks
